Definitions of Terms and Source Notes

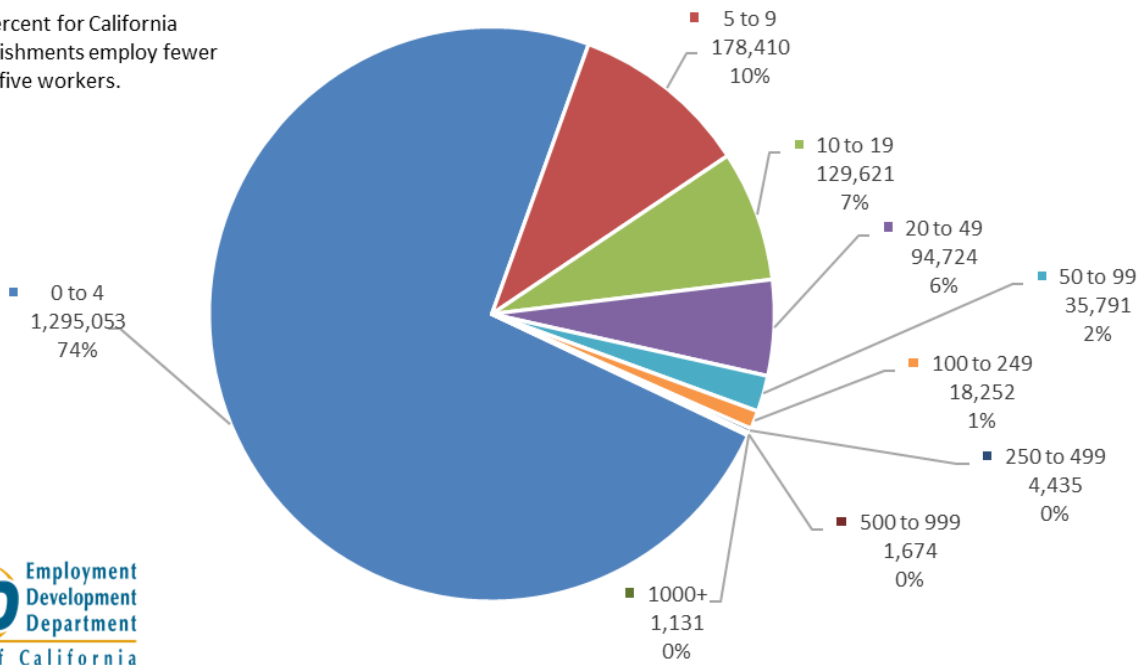

Beginning 2017/1, the Size of Business Report uses Average Monthly Employment (AME) instead of third-month employment. The industry standard was to report employment using third month, but average monthly employment is now California's data standard. The average value of the three months of the quarter results in a more complete employment picture.

Data may not add due to rounding.

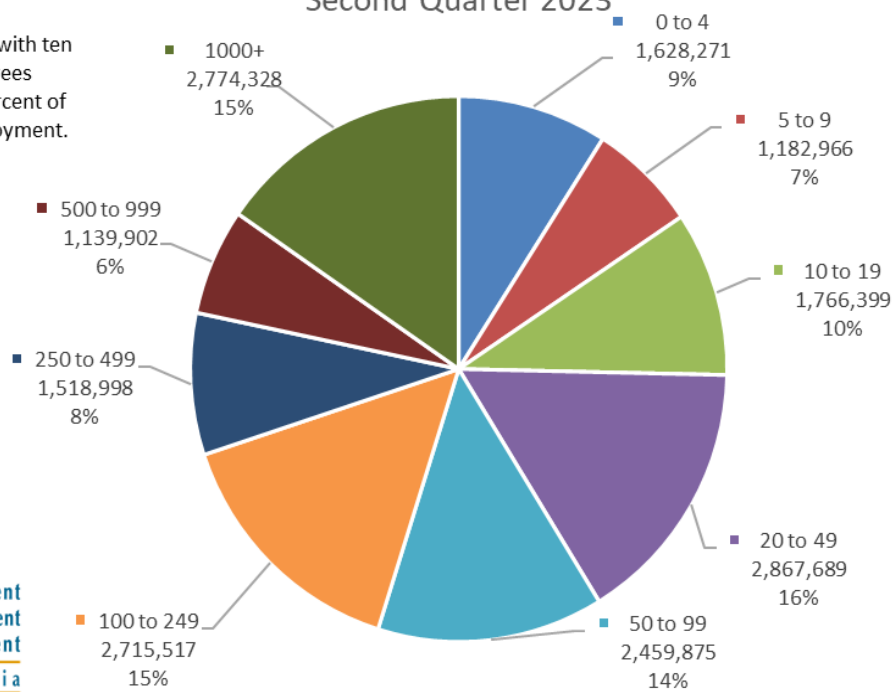
California Establishments by Size Class Second Quarter 2023
