

## IMMEDIATE RELEASE MODESTO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Stanislaus County)

The unemployment rate in the Stanislaus County was 7.0 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 7.5 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.0 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
