SAN FRANCISCO-REDWOOD CITY-SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO METROPOLITAN DIVISION (SAN FRANCISCO AND SAN MATEO COUNTIES) <u>Construction lost 1,700 jobs over the month</u>

The unemployment rate in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD was 3.4 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 3.6 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 2.6 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in San Francisco County, and 3.3 percent in San Mateo County.

Between March 2024 and April 2024, the total number of jobs in the San Francisco-Redwood City-South San Francisco MD, which includes the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo, increased by 700 jobs to total 1,158,500 jobs.

- Private education and health services increased the most over the month by adding 1,300 jobs. More than three-quarters of the employment expansion was in the health care and social assistance (up 1,000 jobs) subsector.
- Leisure and hospitality placed second with a modest uptick of 900 jobs. In detail, arts, entertainment, and recreation picked up 500 jobs and accommodation and food services climbed up 400 jobs.
- On the contrary, construction shed 1,700 positions as the spring season unfolds. This decline is primarily attributed to a decrease in specialty trade contractors (down 1,000 jobs), with the remainder from construction of buildings (down 500) and heavy and civil engineering construction (down 200).
- Professional and business services reported a month-over net loss of 600 jobs. Moreover, professional, scientific, and technical services (down 1,300 jobs) largely outweighed the 700 jobs gained by the other subsectors.

Between April 2023 and April 2024, the total number of jobs in the counties of San Francisco and San Mateo decreased by 9,100 jobs, or 0.8 percent.


- Information (down 11,400 jobs) and professional and business services (down 10,100) combined accounted for 80 percent of the region's year-over employment decline. Among the subsectors, professional, scientific, and technical services (down 9,100) had the most prominent shrinkage.
- Private education and health services (up 7,500 jobs) demonstrated the greatest improvement, chiefly due to growth in health care and social assistance (up 6,800).
- Leisure and hospitality expanded payroll by introducing 3,700 jobs. The addition was evenly distributed across accommodation and food services (up 1,900 jobs) and arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 1,800).
- Government (up 2,900 jobs), other services (up 2,500), and trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,000) also illustrated upward trends in staffing levels.
