

SAN LUIS OBISPO-PASO ROBLES-ARROYO GRANDE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (San Luis Obispo County)

The unemployment rate in San Luis Obispo County was 3.5 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 3.9 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 2.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
