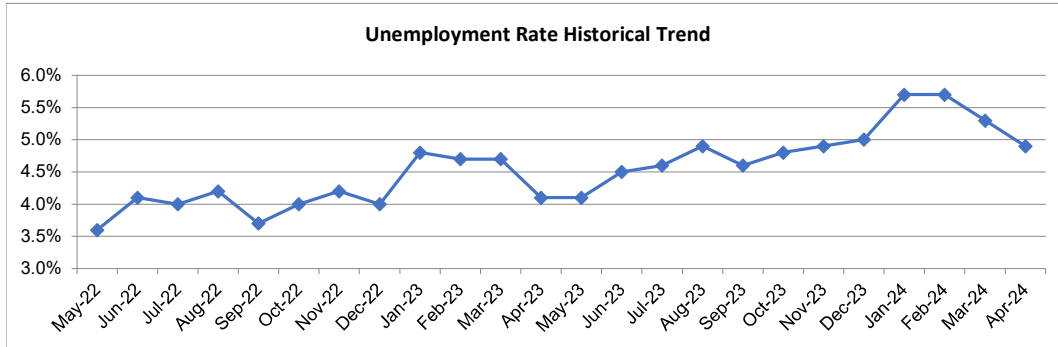


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 VALLEJO-FAIRFIELD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (Solano County)

The unemployment rate in the Solano County was 4.9 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 5.3 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 4.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period.
