

IMMEDIATE RELEASE YUBA CITY METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Sutter and Yuba Counties)

The unemployment rate in the Yuba City MSA was 8.2 percent in April 2024, down from a revised 9.2 percent in March 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 7.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.5 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 8.8 percent in Sutter County, and 7.3 percent in Yuba County.
