

IMMEDIATE RELEASE EL CENTRO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (Imperial County)

The unemployment rate in the Imperial County was 13.0 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 11.5 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 18.8 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
