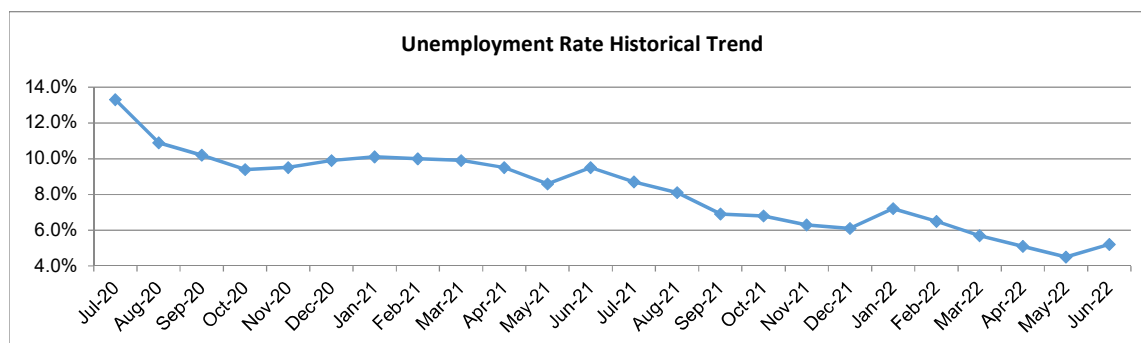


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 MODESTO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Stanislaus County)

The unemployment rate in the Stanislaus County was 5.2 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 4.5 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 9.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
