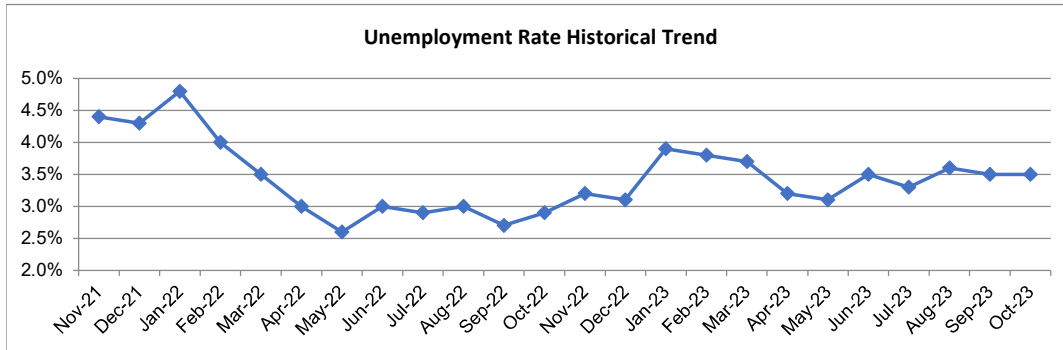


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 NAPA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Napa County)

The unemployment rate in the Napa County was 3.5 percent in October 2023, unchanged from a revised 3.5 percent in September 2023, and above the year-ago estimate of 2.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.8 percent for California and 3.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
