Leisure and hospitality carries month and year-over job growth

The unemployment rate in the Oakland-Hayward-Berkeley MD was 3.0 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 2.6 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 2.9 percent in Alameda County, and 3.2 percent in Contra Costa County.

Between May 2022 and June 2022, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay counties of Alameda and Contra Costa increased by 7,600 to total 1,183,600.

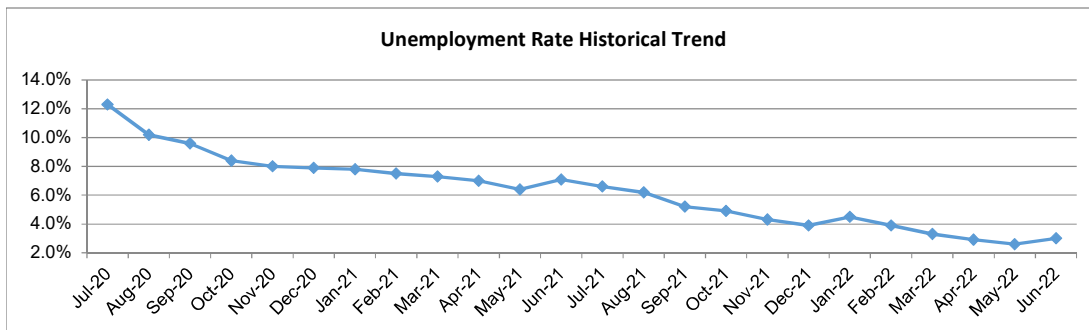
- Leisure and hospitality (up 3,900 jobs) led month-over gains. Accommodation and food services (up 3,600 jobs) accounted for about ninety-two percent of the growth.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities advanced by 2,400 jobs. Retail trade (up 1,100 jobs), transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 700), and wholesale trade (up 600) all contributed to the improvement.
- Manufacturing posted 1,700 jobs to its payrolls, all in durable goods.
- In contrast, government netted a loss of 1,900 jobs. State government cutback 1,900 jobs and federal government decreased by 100 jobs, while local government excluding educational services added 1,500 jobs.

Between June 2021 and June 2022, the total number of jobs located in the East Bay increased by 51,600, or 4.6 percent.

- Leisure and hospitality (up 14,100 jobs) continued to lead year-over recovery. Most of the increase was concentrated in accommodation and food services (up 12,600 jobs).
- Trade, transportation, and utilities expanded by 9,700 jobs. About fifty-four percent of the growth came from retail trade (up 5,200 jobs), while transportation, warehousing, and utilities added 3,000 jobs, and wholesale trade gained 1,500 jobs.
- Private educational and health services picked up 7,700 jobs. A bulk of the jobs were posted in health care and social assistance (up 6,700 jobs).
- Other notable growth included: manufacturing (up 6,200 jobs), government (up 6,100), other services (up 4,200), and professional and business services (up 4,000).
