**ANAHEIM-SANTA ANA-IRVINE METROPOLITAN DIVISION

Nonfarm payrolls up 9,800 over the month and 76,100 over the year

The unemployment rate in the Orange County was 2.9 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 2.4 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between May 2022 and June 2022, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,652,700 to 1,657,600, a gain of 4,900 jobs.

- Leisure and hospitality added 2,000 jobs, the most of any sector. All of the gains were in accommodation and food services (up 2,200 jobs) and centered around food services and drinking places (up 1,800). These increases were offset by a decline of 200 jobs in arts, entertainment, and recreation.
- Employment increased in seven other sectors: manufacturing (up 1,600 jobs), trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,300 jobs), Government (up 1,200 jobs), other services (up 800 jobs), financial activities (up 800), professional and business services (up 600 jobs), and information (up 400 jobs).
- Educational and health services experienced the largest month-over job decline (down 2,000 jobs). Private educational services (down 1,800 jobs) accounted for most of the decline and shortened payroll lists as schools closed for summer recess.
- The only other industry sector that posted a job decline was construction (down 1,800 jobs). Mining and logging remained unchanged.

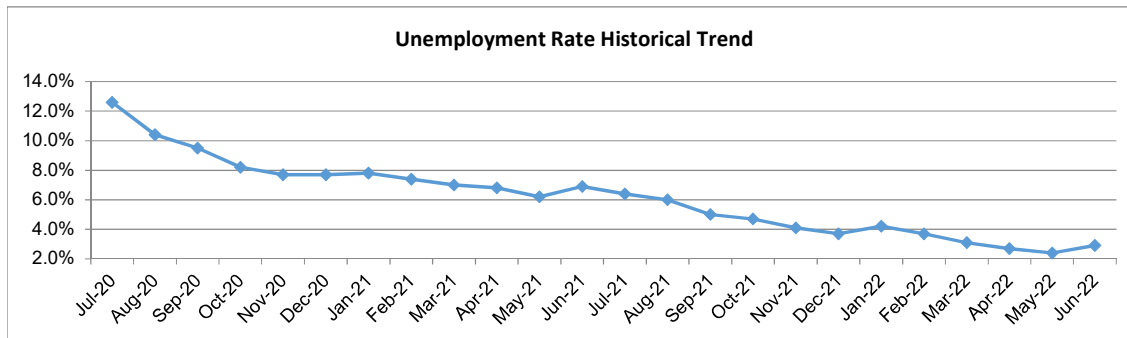
Between June 2021 and June 2022, total nonfarm employment increased by 78,800 jobs, or 4.9 percent.

- Staffing levels increased in nine of eleven industry sectors. The largest employment gain was in leisure and hospitality (up 37,600 jobs), accounting for 48 percent of the total year-over growth. Sector gains were driven by job increases in both accommodation and food services (up 22,300 jobs) and arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 15,300 jobs).
- Professional and business services increased by 10,600 jobs, with 54 percent of the gain in administrative and support services (up 5,700 jobs) which includes employment services (up 5,000 jobs). Educational and health services grew 7,900 jobs and government added 7,700 jobs over the year.
- Six industry sectors had increases of less than 6,000 payroll jobs. Combined, they accounted for 23 percent of total year-over gain (up 17,900 jobs). Mining and logging had no employment changes over the year, and financial activities contracted by 1,000 jobs.
