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**SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA
(SAN DIEGO COUNTY)**
Nonfarm payrolls up 4,300 over the month; up 79,700 over the year

The unemployment rate in the San Diego County was 3.2 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 2.7 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 7.3 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between May 2022 and June 2022, nonfarm employment increased by 4,300, from 1,513,200 to 1,517,500. In addition, agricultural employment added 400 jobs.

- Leisure and hospitality led the month-over increase, adding 4,600 jobs. Accommodation and food services saw an upswing of 3,400 jobs, where notably food services and drinking places increased by 2,700 jobs. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 1,200) made up the remaining job expansion.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities increased by 3,100 jobs. Retail trade boosted the overall sector with a 1,800 job increase. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 700) and wholesale trade (up 600) completed the payroll gain.
- Five other industries reported an increase in employment, including government (up 400), educational and health services (up 400), financial activities (up 200), manufacturing (up 200), and information (up 100). Employment remained unchanged in mining and logging.
- Professional and business services decreased by 3,200 jobs. All job losses were in administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (down 3,900). On the contrary, professional, scientific, and technical services (up 600) and management of companies and enterprises (up 100) improved employment.
- Construction (down 900) and other services (down 600) recorded employment losses.

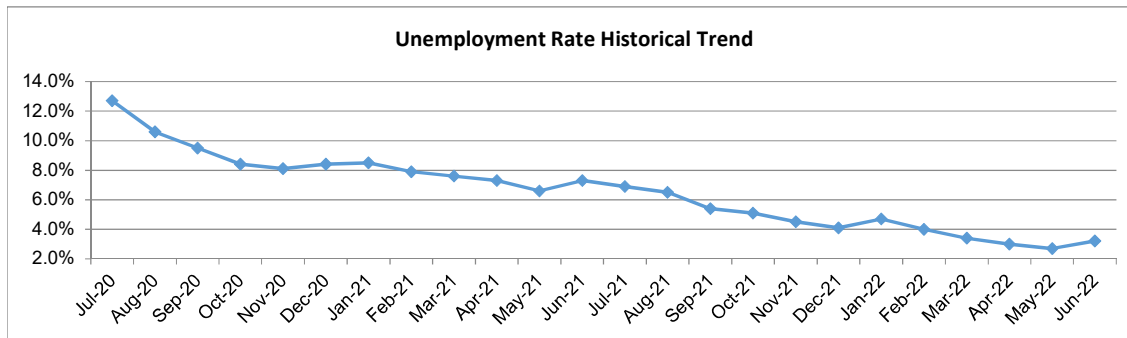
Between June 2021 and June 2022, nonfarm employment increased by 79,700 (up 5.5 percent). Agricultural employment increased by 700, from 9,200 to 9,900.

- Leisure and hospitality rose by 32,500 jobs, the most significant increase over the year. Accommodation and food services (up 25,100) accounted for approximately 77 percent of the rise; notably, food services and drinking places increased by 20,000 jobs. Arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 7,400) made up the remaining job expansion.
- Over the year, professional and business services experienced a job growth of 15,600. Payrolls increased in professional, scientific, and technical services (up 9,200) and administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (up 6,700). Contrarily, management of companies and enterprises (down 300 jobs) declined.
- Year-over employment advancements were also reported in trade, transportation, and utilities (up 9,700), government (up 9,500), other services (up 6,500), educational and health services (up 3,000), construction (up 2,500), financial activities (up 1,100), and information (up 200). Employment remained unchanged in mining and logging. Conversely, manufacturing recorded an employment loss of 900.
