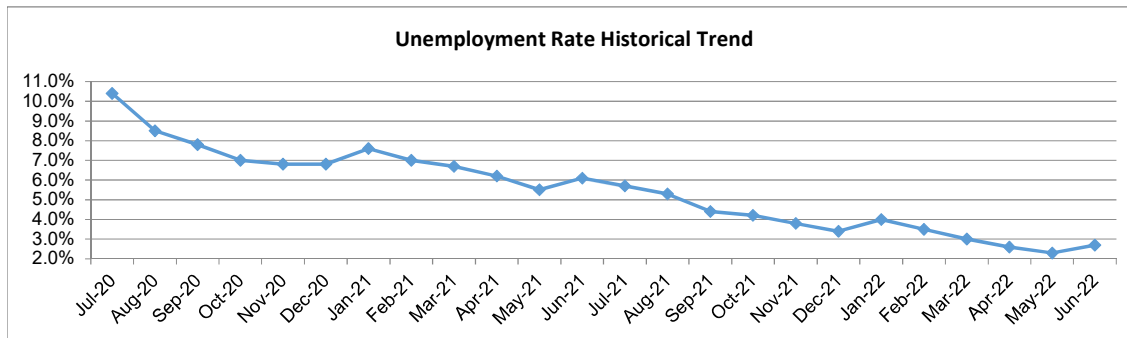


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 SANTA ROSA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Sonoma County)

The unemployment rate in the Sonoma County was 2.7 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 2.3 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 6.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
