SAN JOSE-SUNNYVALE-SANTA CLARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (SAN BENITO AND SANTA CLARA COUNTIES) Total wage and salary increased 0.3 percent over the month and year

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The unemployment rate in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA was 4.1 percent in June 2024, up from a revised 3.5 percent in May 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 3.7 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.3 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 6.3 percent in San Benito County, and 4.1 percent in Santa Clara County.

Between May 2024 and June 2024, total employment in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA, which also includes San Benito County, increased by 3,900 jobs to reach 1,170,300.

- Information added 1,800 month-over jobs; a notable improvement after seven consecutive months of losses in the industry.
- Professional and business services showed improvements, expanding by 1,500 jobs from May to June. Professional, scientific, and technical services (up 1,300 jobs) accounted for about 86 percent of the growth.
- On the other hand, private education and health services contracted 2,000 jobs. Private educational services dropped 1,100 jobs, presumably due to the end of the school year. Health care and social assistance also cut 900 positions.
- Other notable gains and losses included: trade, transportation, and utilities (up 900 jobs), leisure and hospitality (up 800), and government (down 700).

Between June 2023 and June 2024, combined employment in the South Bay counties of San Benito and Santa Clara, increased by 3,000 jobs, or 0.3 percent.

- Private education and health services reported a gain of 10,100 jobs from the previous year during the month of June. The majority of the job gains were in health care and social assistance (up 8,300 jobs).
- Professional and business services saw an uptick of 4,600 jobs. Additions to administrative and support and waste management and remediation services (up 3,200 jobs) accounted for approximately 70 percent of the overall growth.
- Contrarily, manufacturing (down 6,800 jobs) took a downturn over the year. Durable goods presented losses of 7,300 positions, offset by a slight gain in non-durable goods (up 500).
- Despite the month-over improvement for the information sector, the data shows that jobs in information have declined by 6,800 over the year.


