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**SAN JOSE-SUNNYVALE-SANTA CLARA METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
(SAN BENITO AND SANTA CLARA COUNTIES)**
Excellent year-over job gains in most major industries

Between May 2022 and June 2022, total employment in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA, which also includes San Benito County, increased by 10,300 jobs to reach 1,166,700.

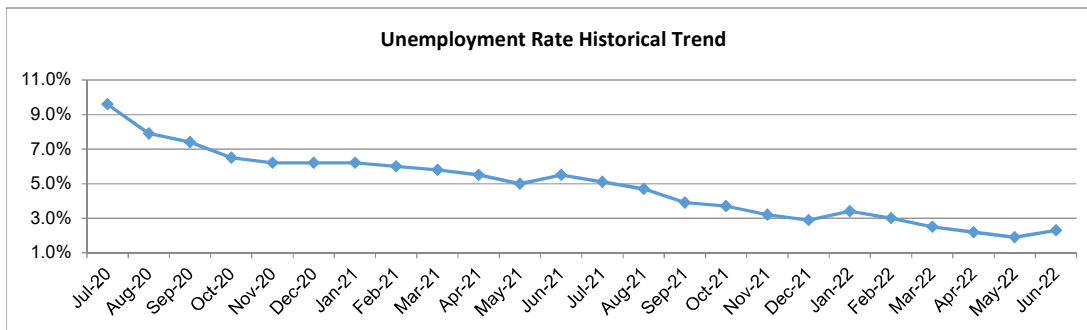
- Leisure and hospitality added 2,300 month-over job gains, with food services and drinking places (up 1,800 jobs) continuing to see the most growth.
- Manufacturing (up 2,100 jobs) grew by 2,000 jobs in durable goods.
- Information and professional and business services each had an increase of 2,000 jobs from the previous month. Professional and business services continues to see the largest increase in professional, scientific, and technical services (up 1,900 jobs).
- Government had a net gain of 800 jobs. The additions to local government (up 800 jobs) more than offset the cutbacks of 300 jobs. Within local government, the additions to local government excluding educational services (up 1,100 jobs) more than offset the cutbacks in local government educational services (down 300 jobs).

Between June 2021 and June 2022, combined employment in the South Bay counties of San Benito and Santa Clara, increased by 60,400 jobs, or 5.5 percent.

- Leisure and hospitality reported a gain of 19,200 jobs from the previous year during the month of June. The majority of the job gains were in food services and drinking places (up 15,400 jobs).
- Professional and business services expanded by 13,900 jobs. Thousands of jobs added in both professional, scientific and technical services (up 10,900 jobs) and administrative and support and waste management and remediation (up 2,700 jobs).
- Private educational and health services improved by 7,000 jobs.
- Other notable year-over gains: manufacturing (up 6,500 jobs), information (up 5,000), construction (up 3,100), trade, transportation and utilities (up 2,700), and government (up 2,400).

The unemployment rate in the San Jose-Sunnyvale-Santa Clara MSA was 2.3 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 1.9 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 5.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period. The unemployment rate was 4.2 percent in San Benito County, and 2.2 percent in Santa Clara County.
