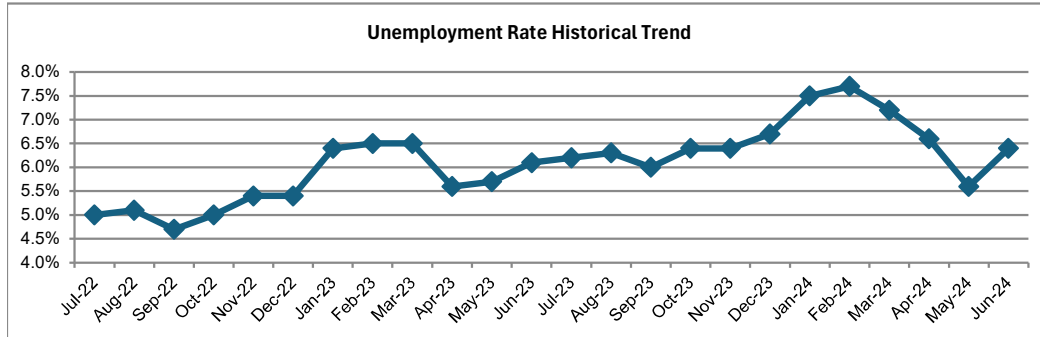


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 6.4 percent in June 2024, up from a revised 5.6 percent in May 2024, and above the year-ago estimate of 6.1 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.3 percent for California and 4.3 percent for the nation during the same period.
