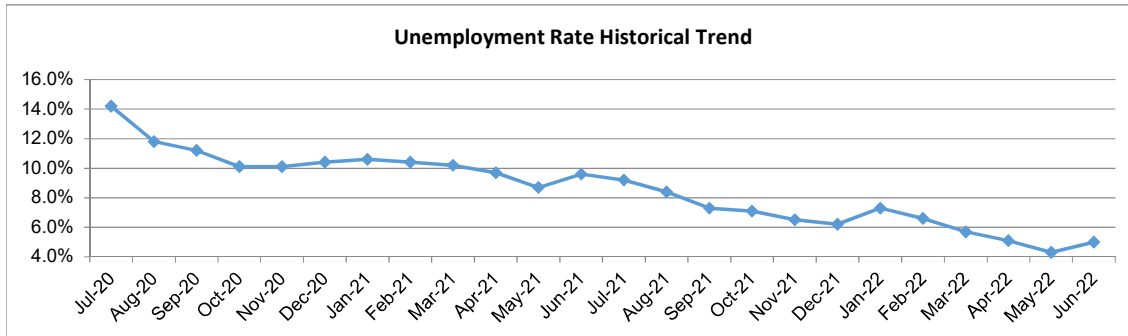


IMMEDIATE RELEASE
 STOCKTON-LODI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)
 (San Joaquin County)

The unemployment rate in the San Joaquin County was 5.0 percent in June 2022, up from a revised 4.3 percent in May 2022, and below the year-ago estimate of 9.6 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 4.0 percent for California and 3.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
