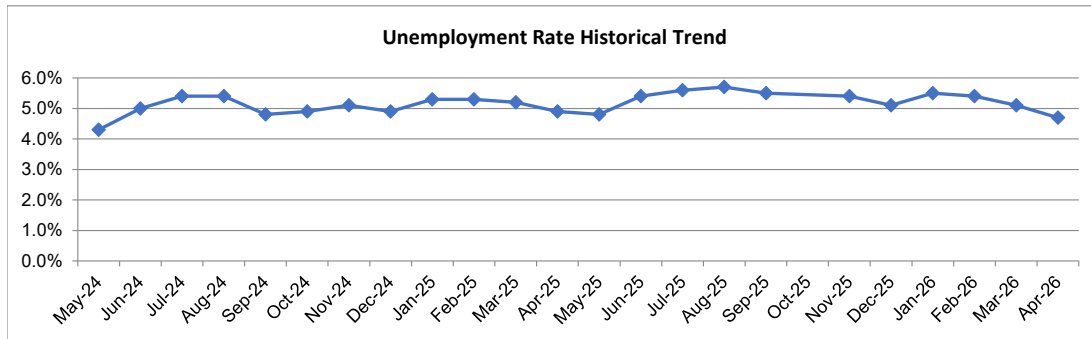


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 VALLEJO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (Solano County)

The unemployment rate in Solano County was 4.7 percent in April 2026, down from a revised 5.1 percent in March 2026, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.0 percent for California and 4.0 percent for the nation during the same period.
